

Rosary of the Communion of Saints

You can use this rosary to ask important graces, to intercede or even for graces of healing or conversion of loved ones. Learn to ask for what you need most, because the graces you need most are spiritual ones and we do well to ask you for us and for everyone, especially sainthood.

Promises of God the Father for those who recite it:

- 1) You who pray with love this rosary at least once a month, I will make you saints in My eyes, with a sanctity suited to you that you will love very much;
- 2) I will make you Christians with a big heart for the good of God and of others. I will make you worshipers of God in Spirit and Truth;
- 3) You will love to see how your lives and souls grow in holiness;
- 4) The soul of those who recite it with devotion It will belong to me forever and woe to those who hurt her;
- 5) Saints and Angels will be friends and will support you in trials and sorrow, the Holy Spirit will help you to be Saints and to save you;
- 6) Friendship with the Saints will become your strength and you will become full of blessings.

It is recited like a normal rosary but the following prayer is recited instead of the Hail Mary: " Holy Ave, full of grace, the Lord is with you. You are good and blessed among women and good and blessed are the Saints and the Angels, working for our salvation and eternal good. Holy women, followers of the Gospel and of Christianity, together with the Saints, the Martyrs and the Angels, pray for the conversion, healing, salvation and redemption of us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen. Thank you."

You can use the normal mysteries of the Rosary or the following mysteries:

1st mystery: "The charity and evangelical goodness of the saints and the angels"

2nd mystery: "The virtues and high prayer of the saints and angels"

3rd mystery: "The noble word and teaching of the saints and angels"

4th mystery: "Meditation and understanding of the divine and heavenly mysteries of saints and angels"

5th mystery: "Sacrifice and good will and holy works for the Gospel and the Christian faith of saints, martyrs and angels"
